CALL FOR ENTRIES / PROSPECTUS



Established in 1996, the Center draws art collectors & patrons from nearby Orange, Riverside, Los Angeles, and San Diego Counties and beyond for this prestigious annual international show & sale attended by over 10,000 visitors.

ELIGIBILITY: Open only to artists who hold Signature Membership status in one or more U.S. watercolor/ watermedia societies or associations. Digital entries only—JPEG or TIFF format. Must be watermedia on paper or Yupo and have been completed in the past 2 years and not previously shown at FAC. Mixed media and collage acceptable (water based).

SHOW TERMS: Up to 120 Works will be selected. Artists may submit 2 works; Only 1 work per artist is eligible for acceptance into the exhibition. Ms. Warren will make the selection for inclusion from the digital images submitted; the selection of awards will be made in person.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: Nov 17, 2018. **Notifications by:** Dec 15, 2018 **Accepted Work due at the Center:** Jan 18, 2019

AWARDS: \$15,000 in cash and merchandise awards including Best of Show \$2,500 | First Place \$2,000

Soon Y. Warren, NWS, AWS, TWSA, TWS | Texas

Soon Y. Warren is a full-time artist and teacher. She has an associate degree in commercial art from Thomas Nelson Community College in Hampton, Virginia, and is a signature member of the National Watercolor Society, American Watercolor Society, Southern Watercolor Society, Texas Watercolor Society, and Society of Watercolor Artists.

She served as a Juror for the NWS Int'l Exhibition in 2015 and the TWSA 42nd National Exhibition with John Salminen in 2018.

Her work has earned numerous awards and she has published two watercolor painting technique books, "Vibrant Flowers in Watercolor" with F&W Publication, (North Light Book) in March 2006 and "Painting Vibrant Watercolor: Discover the Magic of Light, Color and Contrast" published in 2009.

Soon was born in South Korea and immigrated to the U.S. in 1987. Her favorite subjects are those found in nature: people, animals, trees, a tangerine, pear, oriental poppies and she is known for her spectacular renderings of everyday objects. Visit her website: www.soonwarren.com

AWARDS \$15,000 in cash and merchandise awards will be awarded.

FEES \$35 for 1 image | \$45 for 2 images (all fees are non-refundable; CD's or thumb drives will not be returned)
\$45 handling & storage fee (per box) will be charged for all shipped paintings
Shipping fees (both ways) are the responsibility of the artist

FRAMING AND SIZE REQUIREMENTS: Minimum Image Size: 9" x 12" | Max Framed Size: 72" (on 1 side)

Selected artwork must be suitably framed for exhibition. The painting must be ready for hanging with wire, and secured under Plexiglas. No glass. No saw tooth hangers. **Keep matting and framing minimal and clean (simple frames are encouraged - no heavy ornate wood frames please).** Mats, if used, must be white or a light neutral color. FAC may rescind the right of hanging to any work unsuitably presented or misrepresented.

ACCEPTED WORKS

Works may be hand delivered. Shipping fees to and from the Art Center are the responsibility of the artist. Please include pre-paid return shipping documentation. A \$45 handling & storage fee will be charged for all shipped paintings (per box). FAC strongly encourages the use of the Airfloat StrongBox.

SALES

Exhibited works will be consigned for sale at the price submitted on the entry form. FAC will handle all sales, collection, reporting, and payment of applicable sales tax. 35% sales commission. Artists are responsible for all governmental reporting.

INSURANCE

Works selected for the exhibition are covered under FAC's \$1,000,000 Fine Art Insurance Policy for stated value less the 35% commission. Substantiation of value is the responsibility of the Artist.

SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

A Maximum of 2 paintings can be submitted . Application must be completed and entry fees paid in order to be considered. Digital formats: JPG or TIFF, 1MB+ preferred. All submissions will be acknowledged within 2 days of receipt.
